We hereby wish to refer to the events of Thursday, 10 September 2009. At 9:45 a.m. and until 11:45 a.m. when Guauguaychú Environmental Surveillance staff arrived at the General San Martín International Bridge, “bad odours” from the Botnia plant were smelt. This assertion can be made because of the wind direction at the time. Photos were taken and the air was sampled using a portable sampling station.
