That at daybreak, approximately at 3:30 hours on 30th January, 2008 she was working at the Ñandubaysal Beach Resort and she started to perceive a very strong odour (alike decomposed sludge) and similar to some chemical substance, and she calculates that the odour was felt for around 15 minutes; she also says that a white plume of smoke was seen coming from Botnia's stack, and adds that the wind direction was constantly changing and that in the place where she was working (café and tea room) there were tourists that perceived the same odour she is bearing witness to.

while being at his store, bicycles and carts rental, at the Ñandubaysal Beach Resort, at daybreak on 29th January, 2008 at 1:20 hours, and having an after-dinner conversation with a group of tourist friends that were camping at the Beach Resort, they started perceiving a foul odour, that could be compared with rotten eggs. Looking for the origin of the foul odour they went to the shoreline and there they saw a fog hovering over Botnia's plant and, because of the prevailing wind they realised that the odour came from there, and it lasted for 50 to 60 minutes. At daybreak on 30th January, 2008 and being at the Scorpio café and tea-room around 3:00 to 3:15 they again perceive the same odour coming from the pulp mill.

she testifies that at dawn (1:15 hours) on Monday 29th January, 2008 while being at the bar of the café and tea-room of the Ñandubaysal Beach Resort she started to perceive a strong odour – like being in a tannery and also like smell of burnt leather – and that in that moment, some tourists enter the saloon but leave very rapidly due to the strong odour; she states that according to her estimate the foul odour stood there for some 50 minutes and that after 15 minutes it had started she began to feel nausea and also states that looking at Botnia’s pulp mill one could see a low altitude layer of foggy grey smoke and that by the stack one could see a large plume of white smoke. She informs that today, 30th January, 2008 at 3:30 hours the same phenomenon occurred again, and was witnessed by tourists.

she states that at daybreak of 29th January, 2008 while she was at work at the café and tea-room of the Ñandubaysal Beach Resort at 1:30 hours, all of a sudden she starts to sense a foul odour (she compares it with tannery odour) and as minutes went by the odour grew stronger, and that the duration of this foul odour was of around 45 to 50 minutes; she also reports that the odour kept changing and at times it smelled like rotten eggs and that during these moments she was together with a fellow worker that also felt the same odour, and also informs that she felt indisposition in her nostrils and further states having seen large quantities of smoke hovering over the Botnia pulp mill, and also states that at daybreak today the episode repeated itself.

while working at the kitchen of the café and tea-room of the Ñandubaysal Beach Resort, he perceives a strong foul odour which at first he thought came from the rest rooms; when he comes out and goes up to the veranda, after checking on the condition of the rest rooms that were OK, he comes to the conclusion and also by comments from his fellow workers and tourists, that were covering their noses, he realizes that the foul odour came from the Botnia pulp mill, and lasted for around 45 to 60 minutes. He compares the odour with a sewer or rotten eggs, and the incident took place at daybreak of 29th January, 2008 at 1:30 hours, repeating itself exactly as mentioned on 30th January, 2008 at dawn but for a much shorter period of time.

He also explains that during today's dawn approximately at 3:30 hours a similar incident occurred, which lasted less time or around 15 to 20 minutes.
